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1. BEFORE YOU START

1.1 REQUIREMENTS

To start using AT&T Social Net on your mobile phone, you must have the following:

- An AT&T Social Net-compatible mobile phone
- A mobile data service subscription

AT&T Social Net currently supports [Facebook](#), [MySpace](#), and [Twitter](#), and you can activate any or all services at your convenience.

If you don't already have an account with a service and want to start using it with AT&T Social Net, you'll need to create your new account using the web on your PC first.

2. DOWNLOAD AND INSTALLATION

2.1 INSTALLING THE AT&T SOCIAL NET APPLICATION

When you begin your AT&T Social Net download, you will be asked where you want to save the program. Save AT&T Social Net to your phone's Applications folder.

2.2 LAUNCHING AT&T SOCIAL NET

Next, you will be asked if you want to launch the application. Select **Yes** to launch AT&T Social Net. You can always return to the phone's Applications folder and select **AT&T Social Net** to launch.

Once you launch the application:

1. You'll see screen explaining potential data charges. Select continue and accept the End User License Agreement.
2. Next, you'll see a screen where you'll need to enter your phone number. Type it in, enter your email address (optional) and then press **OK**.
3. You're in! Welcome to the AT&T Social Net Home Screen.

3. SETTING UP AT&T SOCIAL NET

3.1 GETTING STARTED

The diagram in **Figure 1** below explains each item on the AT&T Social Net Home Screen. It also points out the important keys on your mobile phone that you'll use to control AT&T Social Net's features:

3.2 ACTIVATING YOUR SERVICES

The first time you launch AT&T Social Net, the Home Screen will display messages instructing you to sign in to your services. This will be the only time you will need to manually sign into each of your services - after that, you'll be signed in to all of your services automatically every time you launch AT&T Social Net. *

***Note:** You can change this setting if you want. Just open AT&T Social Net's More menu and select "Manage AT&T Social Net." Uncheck the box labeled "Sign Me in Automatically" to set the application to manual login. You can choose whether or not you want AT&T Social Net to save your user names by checking (or unchecking) "Remember Me."

The Carousel

At the top of the screen, you'll see a row of icons displaying all of AT&T Social Net's services. This Carousel is what you'll use to navigate from service to service.



For touch-screen devices:

1. Tap on an icon in the Carousel.
2. You'll immediately move to the page for that service.

For non-touch screen devices:

1. Scroll to the top of the screen to activate the Carousel.
2. Scroll left and right through the icons. As you scroll, you will move through AT&T Social Net's different pages.
3. To select a service, just scroll to the corresponding icon in the Carousel to open it.

***IMPORTANT:** All passwords are case-sensitive, so keep that in mind when you're typing them into the phone. Some devices will capitalize the first letter by default – be sure to manually adjust to lower case as needed.



To sign in to Facebook

1. Enter the email address and password associated with your Facebook account.
2. Select **Sign in**.

***Note:** When you sign into Facebook via AT&T Social Net, you are automatically adding the AT&T Social Net application to your Facebook account. If you log in to Facebook on your PC, you'll see AT&T Social Net listed under "Authorized Applications." Don't worry – this process is just how Facebook enables AT&T Social Net to access your updates and status information.



To sign in to Twitter

1. Enter your Twitter user name and password. (Note: you may also sign in using the email address associated with your Twitter account.)
2. Select **Sign In**.



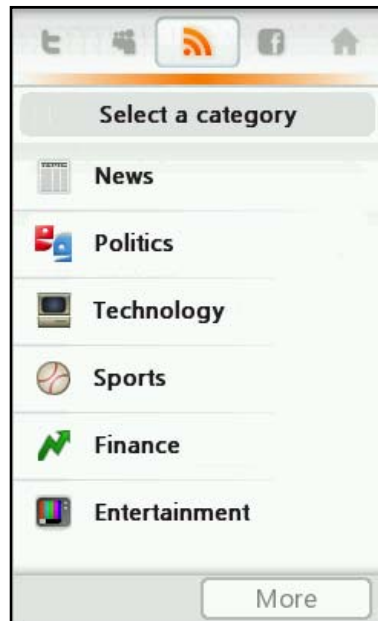
To sign in to MySpace

1. Enter the email address and password associated with your MySpace account.
2. Select **Sign In**.



To subscribe to News feeds

1. Select a Category.
2. Select as many Channels as you like, or press the left soft key to Select All.



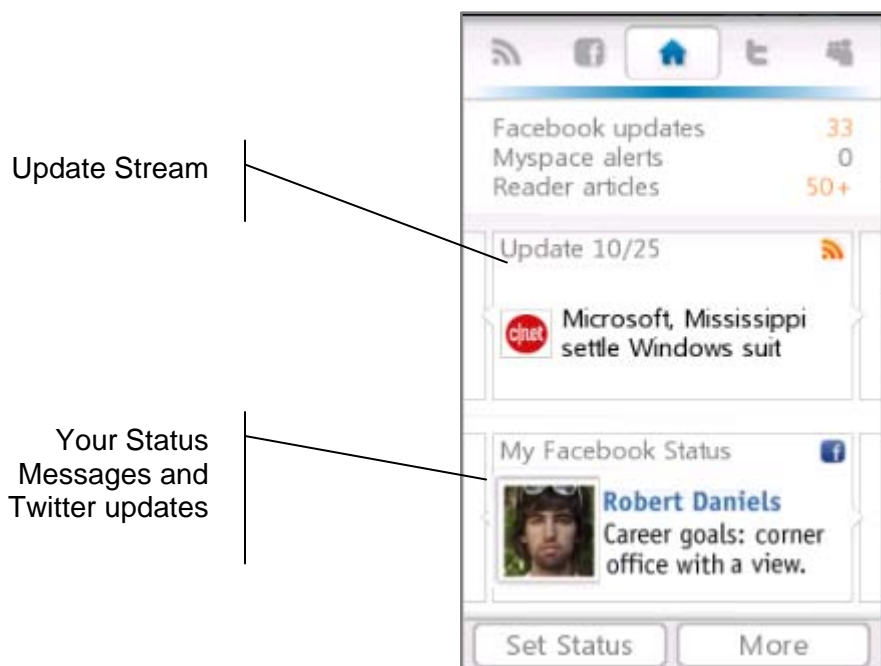
3. Select **Save**.
4. You'll return to the Category list, where you can continue select other Categories and Channels.
5. Once you've selected all the Channels you wish, press **Done**.

4. USING AT&T SOCIAL NET

4.1 THE AT&T SOCIAL NET HOME SCREEN


The Home Screen is designed to give you an at-a-glance summary of your essential web service updates. You will see:

- **Update Stream** –displays your latest Facebook feed items, MySpace updates, News feeds and incoming updates on Twitter. Select the Update stream to navigate directly to the full details of the feed item.
- **Your Status Messages and Tweet** – select this section to edit your Facebook status, MySpace status, and post a new tweet on Twitter.
- Depending on your device, you may also see a tally of the new Facebook updates, MySpace updates and news feeds you’ve received at the top of the screen.



4.2 THE CAROUSEL AND NAVIGATION TABS

As you’ve already seen, scrolling left and right on the Carousel lets you navigate between AT&T Social Net’s pages. But now that you’re signed in to your services, the Carousel will also alert you when you have new updates in your services.

If you’ve received an update, you’ll see the “new content” icon  appear on the corresponding service icon in the Carousel.

When you’re signed in to a service, you’ll notice a set of tabs directly below the Carousel. AT&T Social Net uses these tabs to organize all the content within your services.

If you have a touch-screen device, just tap on the tabs to access each page.



For non-touch-screen devices, scroll down into the page, and then navigate left and right to access the various tabs within that service.

You can return to the Carousel by scrolling LEFT from the leftmost tab or RIGHT from rightmost tab. You can also just scroll back up to the top of the page.

4.3 SHORTCUTS AND ALERTS

4.3a Shortcuts

AT&T Social Net has several shortcuts that make navigating around the application a snap.

For users with touch-screen phones:

A quick tap of the tabs or Carousel will move you instantly to nearly any page in AT&T Social Net.

You can also tap the icon of the service you have open--from virtually any screen in AT&T Social Net--and you'll zip up to very top of the page.

For users with non-touch-screen phones, there are several keys on your mobile phone's keypad that help to make navigating around AT&T Social Net a snap:

For phones with standard key pads:

Press the * **key** from virtually any screen in AT&T Social Net, and you'll zip right back up to the Carousel.

Also, the **"0" key** works like a "page down" button. So when you're navigating through your Facebook feed, Twitter updates, News articles, etc, just press **0** to scroll down an entire page.

For phones with QWERTY key pads:

Both the * **key** and the **"q" key** will take you immediately up to the Carousel.

Both the **"0" key** and the **space bar** function as a "page down" button.

AT&T Social Net has a shortcuts list, including an explanation of how each shortcut works, in the application itself. To view the list: open the More menu and select **Help > Tips and Tricks**.

4.3b Alerts

AT&T Social Net is automatically configured to alert you with a tone and a vibration when an important new update comes in. And if you don't want to leave the application running, AT&T Social Net can even reactivate when it's off in the event that something important comes in.

Of course, these alert settings are all customizable. To configure your alert settings:

1. Open the More menu from any of AT&T Social Net's main screens.
2. Select **Manage Social Net**.
3. You'll notice 3 boxes with check marks, labeled as follows:
 - Audio Alert
 - Vibrate Alert
 - Notifier if Exit - Launches the app to notify you of new messages if you've exited the app.
4. Check or uncheck the boxes of your choosing to modify the alert settings.
5. Press **Save**.

4.4 FACEBOOK

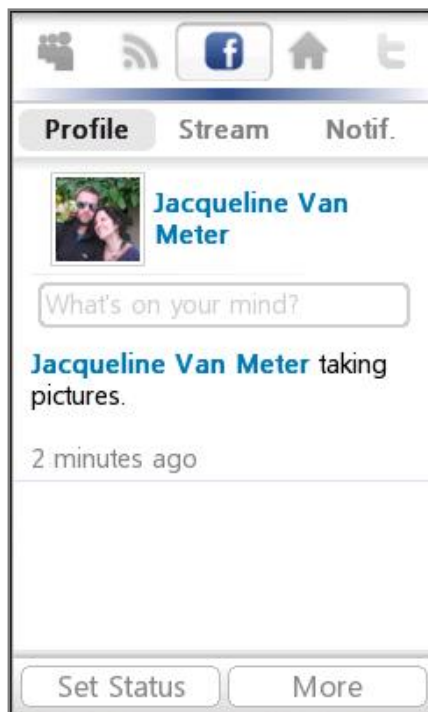
AT&T Social Net's Facebook page divides your Facebook content into 3 areas. From left to right, they are:

4.4a The Profile tab

The Profile tab displays your profile photo and your current status message, which you can edit from this page.

To change your status:

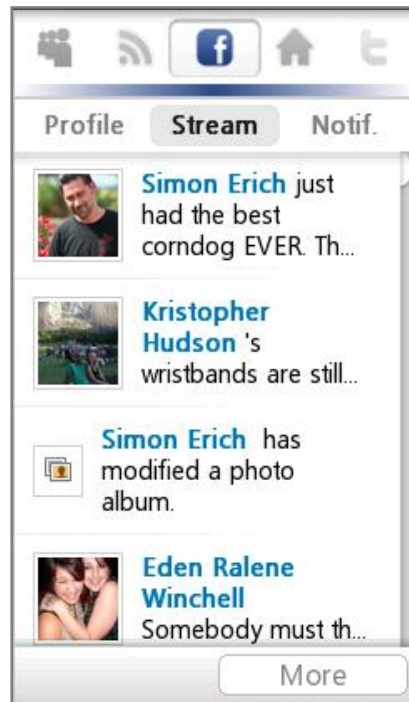
1. **Tap** on the field that says "What's on your mind?" (**touch-screen**), or select the button labeled **Set Status (non-touchscreen)**.
2. Delete the current status message if needed, and type in your new status message.
3. Press **OK**.



4.4b The Stream tab

The Stream tab reports your friends' latest updates on Facebook. This page shows you new status updates and alerts you when friends have added new photos or been tagged in pictures.

You can respond to the items in your feed directly from the AT&T Social Net - view profiles, write on walls, send messages and poke friends!

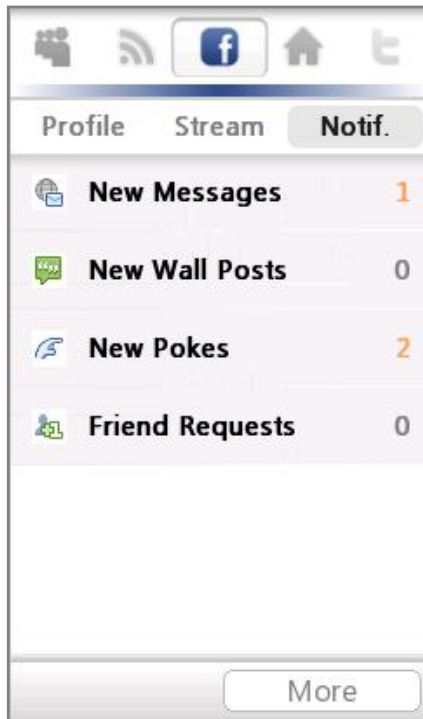


To respond to recent updates:

1. Highlight or select the update.
2. Press **Options**.
3. Select the one of the options to respond to the update. This will launch the Facebook site on your phone's mobile browser. You'll be asked if you want to launch your phone's browser. Select **OK**.
4. Follow the steps on the Facebook website to complete your task. When you're finished, exit the mobile browser to return to the AT&T Social Net application.

4.4c The Notifications Tab

The Notifications tab shows you the tally of new messages, wall posts, pokes, and friend requests you've received.



To view the details of your incoming notifications:

1. Select the Notification you want to see.
2. This will launch the Facebook site on your phone's mobile browser. You'll be asked if you want to launch the browser. Select **Yes/OK**.
3. Follow the steps on the Facebook website to complete view the item. When you're finished, exit the mobile browser to return to the AT&T Social Net application.

4.5 TWITTER

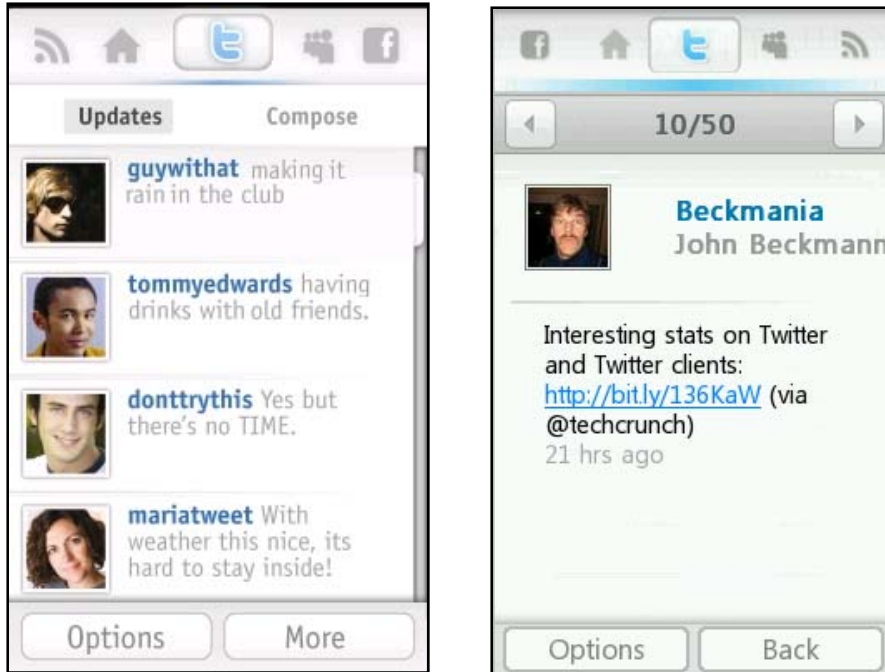
AT&T Social Net's Twitter feature lets you read and reply to the latest updates from your Twitter community, and you can publish new updates of your own.

4.5a The Updates Tab

This tab shows you the most recent updates from your friends on Twitter.

To view an update:

1. Scroll to an item on the list and highlight it.



2. Select the item to read the full update and details.

To @reply to an update:

1. From the Updates tab, highlight or select the update you want to @reply to.
2. Open the Options menu and select **@Reply**.
3. Next, start typing your message. Then press **OK**.
4. Your @reply will at the top of the screen for you to review.
5. Press **Reply**.

To save an update to your Twitter "Favorites:"

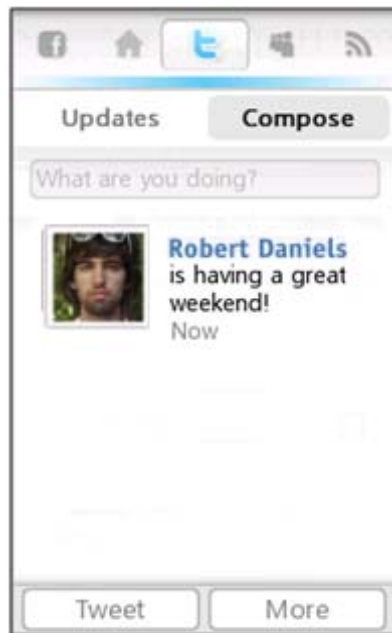
1. From the Updates tab, highlight or select the update you want to save to your Favorites.
2. Open the Options menu and select Add to Favorites.
3. The Update will be saved – you can view it in your Favorites folder the next time you open Twitter on your PC.

4.5b The Compose Tab

From this tab you can see your latest tweet and publish new updates.

To compose a new update:

1. Select the box labeled "What are you doing?," or press the button labeled **Tweet**.
2. **Type** your new message (remember: 140 characters or less!).
3. Press **OK**. You'll see your new message at the top of the screen.



4.6 MYSPACE

AT&T Social Net's MySpace feature lets you view your friends' status and mood on MySpace, set your mood and status and access your inbox, comments, friend requests, photos and more.

4.6a The Home Tab

This tab shows you your current profile picture, status message and mood, and alerts you when you have new activity on MySpace.

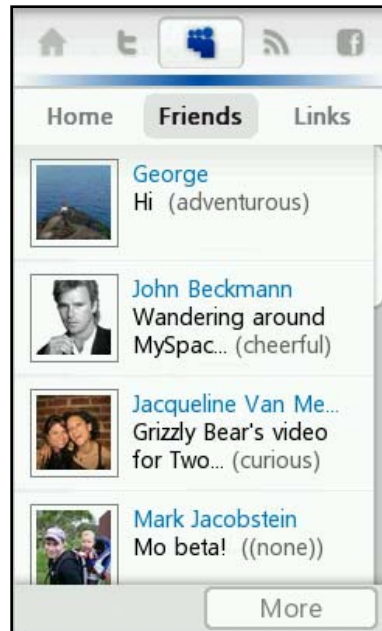
To update your status or mood:

1. Select the button labeled **Set Status**.
2. Enter your new status update in the field at the top.
3. Press **OK**.
4. Select the field below to choose a mood option.
5. Press **Save**.



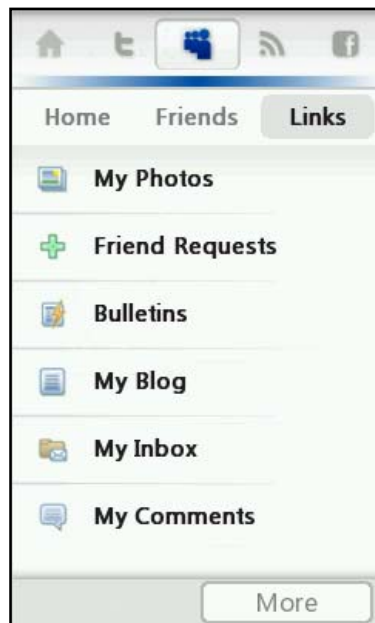
4.6b The Friends Tab

This tab shows you the latest status updates from your friends on MySpace. To view the complete details of an update, just select item in the list. You'll see the entire update and the time the user posted the update.



4.6c The Links Tab

This tab gives you easy access to your MySpace Inbox, comments, friend requests, photos, blog and bulletins.



To access any of these features:

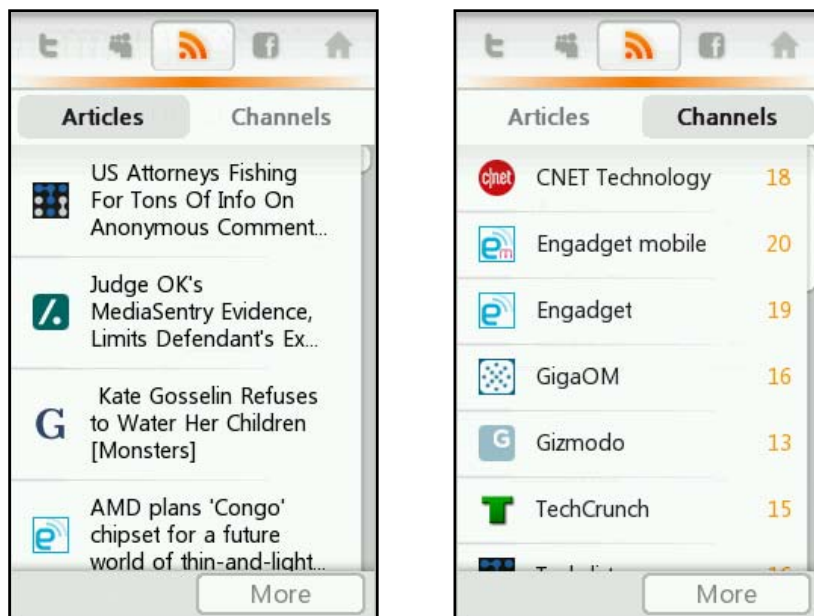
1. Select the feature in the list.
2. This will launch the MySpace site on your phone's mobile browser. You'll be asked if you want to launch the phone's browser. Select **Yes**.

3. Follow the steps on the MySpace website to complete your task. When you're finished, exit the mobile browser to return to the AT&T Social Net application.

4.7 NEWS

AT&T Social Net's News feature lets you subscribe to real-time feeds from a variety of popular news, politics, technology, sports, finance and entertainment sites.

The Articles tab shows you all of your incoming news items, organized from newest to oldest. From this tab, you can read all of your news feeds as they come in. The Channels tab lists the news channels you are currently subscribed to. From here, you can manage your subscriptions and view all the articles from a given source.



4.7a To view a news feed item

1. Open the Articles tab and select an item to read.
2. You will see a screen with the headline of the article, the time the article was published and the first few lines of the story.
3. You can scroll to the right to continue browsing news feed items.
4. To read the full article, open the More menu and select **View in Browser**.
5. You'll be asked if you want to allow AT&T Social Net to access the Web. Select **Yes**. This will direct you to the website where the article was originally published.
6. When you're finished reading the article, close your mobile browser to return to AT&T Social Net.



4.7b To view feed items by channel

1. Open the Channels tab.
2. Select the channel you wish to browse.
3. You'll see the list of all recent feed items from that channel.
4. Select a feed item to read.

4.7c To add new subscriptions

1. From either the Articles or Channels tab, open the More menu and select Add Channel.
2. Select a category and check the box(es) next to your sites of choice. Then press **Save**.
3. Once you are finished adding new subscriptions, press **Done**.

4.7d To unsubscribe to a channel

1. Open the Channels tab and scroll to the channel you want to remove.
2. Open the More menu and select Remove Channel.

4.8 EXITING AT&T SOCIAL NET

To minimize AT&T Social Net (if your phone allows apps to run in the background):

1. Open the More Menu, and select **Minimize AT&T Social Net**.

To exit out of AT&T Social Net:

1. Open the More Menu and select **Exit AT&T Social Net**.

5. HELP

5.1 TIPS AND TRICKS

In the AT&T Social Net **Help** menu, you'll find a page explaining the basics of the AT&T Social Net Home Screen and how to navigate around the application. The page also includes a list of navigation shortcuts and explanations of how each shortcut works.

To view the page:

1. Open the More menu and select **Help > Tips and Tricks**.

5.2 ABOUT AT&T SOCIAL NET

To view what version of AT&T Social Net software is installed on your phone, as well as the version of server software being used:

1. Select **Help > About** from the More menu.
